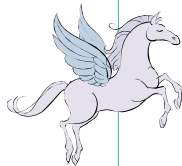

CREATIVE ARTS WEEK AT PAKACHOAG

What to Expect

We'll be offering two different Weekly Themes—so you can choose to sign up for one or two weeks—and have a different experience each week.

- ◆ As part of a small troupe of 'actors' (no more than 8 children), each day, as part of story-time, the children will visit a different place.
- ◆ They'll act out their favorite characters and adventure of the day with support from their coach (and teacher), Ms. Bennett.
- ◆ They'll recount special memories of their visit with a story-related arts and craft activity,
- ◆ And they'll learn some new story-related (and sometimes unrelated) songs for fun.



Students should bring water and a snack each day and wear comfortable clothing and shoes that allow for movement.

Day 1: *The Bremen Town Musicians visit Pakachoag.*

On Day 5, Children will prepare for a short end-of-week performance for parents.
