

Musicianship / Theory 2011-2012 Class & On-Line Curriculum Sign Up

Dear Parents,

September, 2011

At some point in the past few months and/or on your registration form, you have indicated interest in the School's musicianship / theory program. This program includes two options:

- Participation in bi-weekly classes offered in conjunction with the on-line "Theory In a Box" curriculum; or
- Individual sign-up for the on-line curriculum with some e mail support provided by Nike Beaudry, Pakachoag Theory faculty member.

Because the Theory in a Box on-line learning program requires an up front financial commitment on the part of the school, we ask that you make a commitment between now and Monday, September 12th regarding your participation so that we may secure the appropriate number of on-line 'student portals'.

The fees below are based on securing a minimum commitment of at least 10 students.

Classes will be scheduled on Thursdays after school starting at either 3:45 and 4:30. Assignments are made once we review the mix of students and ages. If you have a private lesson on Thursdays and hope to participate, we will do our best to juggle the private lesson schedule with the theory schedule in hopes of your participation. See Item B below.

Section A

1. I would like to have my child/ren participate in both the bi-weekly classes scheduled on Thursdays after school; including use of the Theory In A Box on-line curriculum (requires internet connection/computer at home).

3. I understand that once I commit by signing below, the School will be unable to offer any refunds. However, my child/ren would be able to continue using the on-line curriculum independently even if they do not attend classes for the duration of the school year; and

4. I commit to paying the non-refundable \$75/student fee (\$120 for non-private instruction students). I may choose to pay \$40 during October; and \$35 in January but I understand I will be billed for the full year regardless of whether we opt out of classes and/or lessons part way through the year.

Section B: For students who checked Item A.1 above AND take private lessons on Thursdays, check here and note: If your lesson time and theory class time end up overlapping resulting in your inability to participate in the classes (we'll try to avoid that), you will be given the opportunity to opt out of this commitment.
