



Student Recital – Participation Request Form — Spring 2012 Semester

*Every student who thinks they may wish to participate in an April or May recital:
Please return this form to YOUR TEACHER by: Monday, April 2nd (for May;) or Monday, March 5 (for April).*

We are unable to accommodate requests for specific times. If you hope to participate, please hold from 1:00 to 6:00 p.m. on your calendar. Your assigned session time will be posted one (two if possible) week(s) prior to the recital date.

Please Note:

- **Do not request a specific day for convenience, but only in the event of an unavoidable conflict.**
- Not all teachers are able to attend recitals. If requesting a specific day, this increases the likelihood that your teacher may not be in attendance. You should tell your teacher if you are requesting a specific day (especially if playing a duet).
- If your child is not ready to participate, your teacher will confirm with you (and Mrs. Smongeski) in advance of the recital. Sometimes, a final decision will not be made until the student has played in a performance class one or two weeks prior to the recital.
- Our goal is to make sure everyone is ready for a successful, enjoyable experience. If you are not ready for a recital, your teacher will make an effort to get you scheduled in the next upcoming recital (November, December, April or May).
